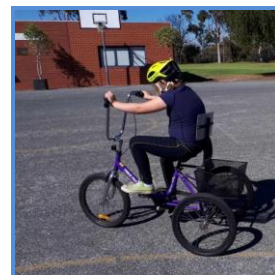
In the Physical Education program, students participate in different activities from cycling, dancing, fine motor skills, and a team sport.

ROOM 10 NEWS



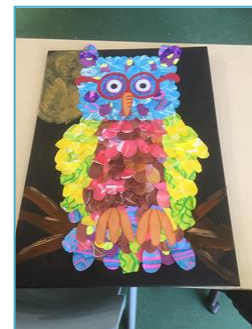
