However, we somehow managed to unravel all his self-restorative efforts by providing him with a backlog of school work to settle him in and welcome him home. - Basketball Silver and a Bronze most improved in basketball passball

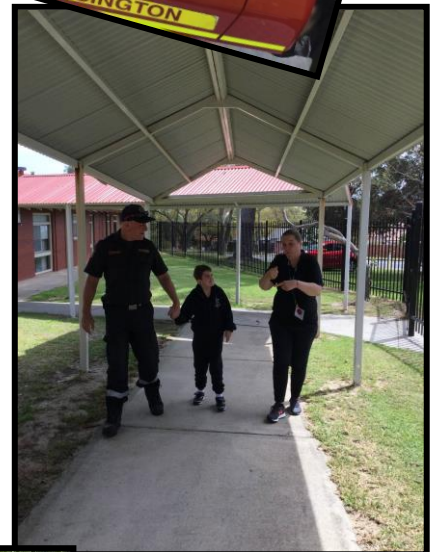
